

Customs Guidance

Following the end of the transition period of the UK's exit from the European Union there will be additional documentation requirements for sending samples to Sciantec from outside the UK, effective from 1st January 2021.

According to UK government guidance any consignments of research and diagnostic samples passing into the UK should be accompanied by a commercial document, ideally a Standard Shipping Note for non-dangerous goods. Please see the example on page 2 for reference. Various versions of this form are easily available online.

To avoid your samples being held in customs please ensure as much of the information below as possible is included on the **outside** of your packaging:

- Sciantec's EORI number: **GB125509721000**
- The description of the material in the package (e.g. Animal feed and feed ingredients), and its origin (the mill location where the sample was taken, e.g. Sciantec Mill, North Yorkshire).
- The description of any animal by-product (including species).
- The quantity of the material held in the package (weigh it before attaching the paperwork).
- The name and address of the Consignee (Sciante Analytical).
- The name and address of the Exporter (your company/organisation)
- **Always** use "Research sample for nutritional testing" for the Description.
- **Always** use "No commercial value" (because the contents are destroyed in processing) for describing any Financial Value.

The carrier will then be able to fill in the rest of the information to ensure smooth progression through customs as far as possible.

This information is correct as of 17/12/2020. Further guidance will be issued as new government information is issued.
