

Getting started

To start, locate the sample you wish to view. The Hub makes it easy to locate your most recent orders and results. For more information on how to locate results for a specific sample, see the help article [Reviewing your most recent orders and results](#).

Once you've identified a sample, visit the **Sample Details** page to view your fertiliser and lime recommendations. To generate the most accurate results, NRM requires the following information from your order:

- Soil Type (light, medium, heavy, etc.)
- Current or planned Crop Type (Winter Wheat, Spring Barley, Field Beans)
- Straw (removed or returned)

Recommendations

Index values are determined from the AHDB Nutrient Management Guide RB209 9th Edition. The analytical methods used to derive recommendations are as described in DEFRA Reference Book 427.

- Fertilisers (P_2O_5 , K_2O , MgO)
 - Calculated using index value, current/planned crop, and presence/absence of straw.
- Lime
 - Calculated using pH, soil type, lime factor for soil, current/planned crop type, lime factor for crops, and optimal pH for the given crop type.
