

Getting Started

We have made it easy to find your most recent results directly from the home page.

1. Visit <https://hub.cawood.co.uk>.
2. **Log in** using your email address as username and Hub password.
3. Once you have logged in, you will be directed to the **Results** page.
4. The results page includes high-level information for each sample.
5. Samples are sorted by most recent **Reported Date** by default.

Results tab

Use the below **Filters** to locate specific samples and results. Filters are derived from the information on the order (card). Use the “**Clear all filters**” option to return to your default samples list.

- **Farm:** lists the ‘client’ name (typically the land where samples were taken).
- **Requestor:** lists the ‘contact’ or rep name (typically the agronomist).
- **Previous Crop:** refers to the crop prior to the current crop.
- **Current Crop:** refers to the current or planned crop.
- **Reported:** allows you to narrow the set of samples to only those *reported* within a pre-defined date range (example: “Past 30 Days”), or a custom date range that you select.

Use **Sorting** to change the top-to-bottom ordering of the sample list.

- Alphabetical sort (ascending) is used for the following:
 - Farm name, Requestor Name, Previous Crop, Current Crop
- Chronological sort (descending) is used for the following:
 - Reported (date)

Sample Details page

Once you have located the desired sample, click or tap the sample record to open the **Sample Details** page. This page contains detailed results information and recommendations. In addition to the on-page information, you can download your results in multiple formats.

- **Download Report (.PDF)**
This provides the NRM report for all samples in the order and includes detailed recommendation notes using AHDB RB209 guidance.
- **Download Data (.CSV)**
